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### About Writing Coaches of Montana

Since its inception in 1995, Writing Coaches of Montana (WCM) has grown from an on-site, drop-in writing center in a single, Missoula school, to a classroom-based, teacher-driven program across Western Montana. We serve Flathead, Missoula, and Ravalli counties.

At the invitation of teachers, trained coaches meet individually with students in the classroom. Coaches work with students in grades 4-12 across disciplines, including science, social studies, and language arts. WCM uses individualized approaches which help students deepen their critical thinking and learn how to develop their writing and revision process.

#### 2738 STUDENTS SERVED IN 19 SCHOOLS

#### WRITING ACROSS DISCIPLINES

Coaches supported students in science, government, social studies, language arts, and humanities classes, partnering with 42 teachers.

#### **TEACHER RECOMMENDED**

100% of teacher survey respondents reported that they would recommend WCM to fellow educators.





#### **1121 HOURS VOLUNTEERED**

Over 100 local community members donated over 1,121 hours working with students in 3,365 sessions. That equates to \$35,747 of in-kind labor!

"Every year, I count on Writing Coaches of Montana to assist me in providing top-notch, individualized writing instruction to students. I can carve out five to seven minutes to conference with individual students on an essay, but this is just not enough for most writers. With the help of writing coaches, my students get that initial visit with me to work on development of basic structural elements such as their thesis, but then they get to meet with a coach twice over two weeks to review all other aspects of their writing. ### **Research-Backed**

Writing Coaches of Montana conducted a study with 10<sup>th</sup> grade students at Columbia Falls High School, with all students completing the same assignment. A team of community members was then trained on a rubric developed by our contracted research expert to anonymously score first and final drafts of each essay.

Students who received one coaching session experienced 2.5 times the growth of students who did not receive coaching.

On a 4-point scale, students who were coached scored 11% higher than students who were not coached.
